

Tech Talk

Software Updates

The fall brings cooler weather to the valley as well as the return of the Snow Birds. Fall is also the time of year that Apple introduces new hardware and new software. I hope to make sense of all the news.

New Software:

There are 3 main types of software upgrades major, minor, and security. **Before doing any upgrade, insure you have a current backup.**

Major Updates:

Major updates are usually introduced once each year. The first number after the "iOS" is changed, for iPhone/iPads, the iOS14.8 upgrades to iOS 15.0. For the Mac the Mac OS 11.6 upgrades to Mac OS 12.0.(Mac OS 11.6 is called Big Sur The upgrade Mac OS 12.0 is called Monterey). Major updates involve major

changes to the operating system to take advantage of the new capabilities of the new hardware. I recommend that our members wait until the new year to allow time for any bugs to be discovered and patched when the first minor update is available.

Minor Updates:

Minor updates can occur throughout the year, to correct programming problems (bugs) discovered after a major update. Minor Updates may also add new options to the original Major updates. Minor updates do not require extensive rewrites of the operating system. Minor updates will change the second/third number iOS 15.0 to iOS15.1 or Mac OS12.0 to Mac 12.1. I recommend upgrading when prompted by Apple.

Security Updates:

Security Updates are a special type of minor update that involves cor-

recting a newly discovered security venerability. This update may or may not change the OS numbering. I recommend upgrading when prompted by Apple.

When to update?

Care must be exercised before doing Major Updates. With the major rewrite/upgrade of the operating system code, older programs and equipment may not operate. If you haven't kept up with the current version, for example, trying to upgrade from mac OS 10.12 Sierra (2016) to 11.0 Big Sur (2020), that 5 year difference can cause some older programs or printers not to run with the current version. It's always a good idea before a major update to make sure all essential programs and other devices connected to the computer are compatible with the updated operating system.
